Materials List

- Any brand of gel plate. I recommend “Gelli Arts” brand Gel Printing Plate - 8" X 10" Gel Plate Currently \$27.55 on Amazon <https://a.co/d/4SL4rCA> You may also find them at Michael’s Arts and Crafts.
- Soft Rubber Brayer (any brand) like this Speedball <https://a.co/d/5BLFfd5>
- Acrylic paints or acrylic-based craft paints in a variety of colors. Anything you have on hand is fine. I will put out some other colors for you to try too!

Michael’s has a lot of inexpensive craft paints [Acrylic Craft Paint](#)
Metallic paints are very beautiful. Avoid glitter paint.
- Paper: regular copy/printer paper, any weight, from Amazon, Target, Office Depot, or wherever you buy paper. You are welcome to bring watercolor paper, Bristol paper, printmaking paper or any paper you enjoy using to make finished prints as well. Bring what you have, no need to buy anything new.
- Deli paper (I will provide this, but if you want your own stash, you can go to Smart & Final, look down low on the shelf by Saran Wrap and Aluminum Foil)
- Scissors
- Masking tape (blue or tan, any is fine)
- Baby wipes (to clean your plate and hands)
- Water spray bottles (we will have these on hand as well)
- Optional: Alignment tool. I will bring one and demo it. There are two options if you decide to invest in one to try it out: [L-shaped Gel Pres Placement Tool](#) is cheaper and looks good to me. The one I have is [Gelli Arts Mini Alignment Tool](#) because that is how I learned.
- Optional: fresh flowers, leaves or grasses. I will bring plenty of these, but if you have something in your garden you want to try, or to share, the more the merrier! Important: No thorns or sharp bits – they can cut your gel plate or your fingers
- Optional: Acrylic Paint Pens or Liquid Markers if you want to draw with paint on your plate
