Sketchbook: Whatever size you have Sharpies - small, medium, large if you have them
(I use Sharpies because they're waterproof)

This materials list is a guide only. If you have materials that are close to the suggested ones please bring them and we can decide if you need to add anything. However, the paper is important and I recommend 100\% cotton. There are several good brands available.
