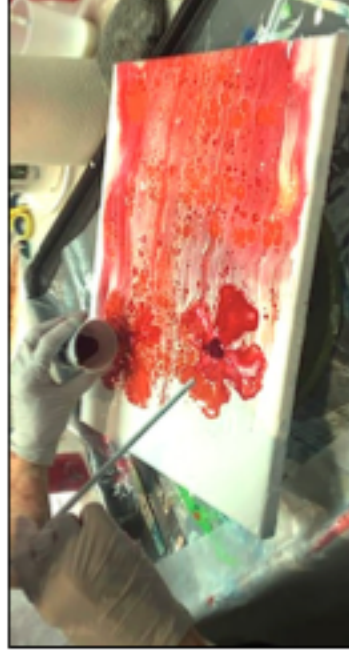


## Paint pouring with Linda

### **No drawing experience necessary**

Learn a whole new way to use acrylics in creating one of a kind pieces.  
Class will focus on a variation of the basic premise. giving you numerous and exciting possibilities to add to your own collection of creative expression. You will complete 2 to 3 paintings each day..

some tools and supplies included. See Supply list

### *Supply List*

Acrylic paint: soft bodied, liquid bottles are best but tubes are OK,( just take longer to mix.)

If you don't have acrylics. the basic red, blue yellow, green and white is enough  
1 inch masking or painters tape

canvases no larger than 12 x 12 4 or 5 for both days.

Drip pan large enough to fit your canvas into with a level bottom for even paint flow

2 Foil cookie sheet from dollar store is fine

Small pieces of good paper : watercolor, paper approximately 5 x 7 to use

Freezer, parchment or waxed paper

Pouring Medium. 1 QT. FloTrol by "FLOOD" on Amazon or Home Depot is the cheapest.

6 once plastic mixing cups

stirring sticks large wood popsicle

pushpins ( for bottom of canvas for easier handling) I will have some

spatula with an angled blade (  )

gloves

Paper towels

apron or clothing you don't want to ever wear again

small kitchen butane torch I will have one available

I will supply anything else just show up and have fun.
